

1914 – Record of Residents from Burg – Fanmore

Burg Farmhouse – Donald and Ann Mackinnon (nee MacInnes) and family: John, Neil, Flora, Maryann, Katie, Christina. John was my father.

Burg Cottage – George, Coll, Hector and Chirsty MacInnes. The three brothers went to Glasgow to learn the trade to be joiners.

Tostary Croft (1) – Coll Maclean and his sister Katie, Katie Ann (niece) and Archie MacDonald (nephew). Had sheep and cows and grew crops.

Tostary Croft (2) – Neil and Mary MacCallum, brother and sister. Had sheep and cows, and grew crops.

Kilninian – Mrs MacLucas and daughter, Flora.

Shepherd's House, Kilninian – John MacDonald and family.

Fanmore School – Mr and Mrs Campbell and Family. Mrs Campbell was school teacher.

Torloisk House – Lord and Lady Alwyne Compton. Mary Ann MacColl, Housekeeper.

The Square, Torloisk – two cottages. Accommodation for estate farm workers and their families.

Manager's House – (road junction) Mr and Mrs Gillies and later a Mr and Mrs MacInnes and Family, and their son Hugh was Estate Manager.

Torloisk Cottages – Accommodation for retired estate workers.

Torloisk Cottage (4) – Accommodation for under gardener for Estate.

Torloisk Cottage (5) – Mr and Mrs Scott and family, Head estate Gardener

Keeper's Cottage – Mr and Mrs MacRae and Family. Mr MacRae was Estate Gamekeeper and then later his son Roderick took over as Gamekeeper.

Fanmore – Mr and Mrs Angus MacColl and Family. Duncan MacColl, son, was estate joiner. Had sheep and cattle.

Grouse Cottage – Mr and Mrs Donald MacColl and family. Donald MacColl was Estate Gamekeeper. Angus, their son saw active service in 1914 – 18 war. Some years afterwards took over as Gamekeeper on the Estate.

Normann's Ruh – Home for the Elderly ladies.

Fanmore Croft – Mr and Mrs Donald Maclean and Family. Their son, Lachlan, was postman, and saw active service through the 1914-18 war. Had sheep, cattle, and grew crops.

Fanmore Croft – Mr and Mrs Donald Allan Maclean and family. James, their son, saw active service in 1914 – 18 and was wounded – lost a limb. Had sheep, cattle, and grew crops.

Fanmore Croft – Mr and Mrs George Maclean and family. Had sheep, cattle and crops.

Fanmore Croft – Mr and Mrs Hector MacColl and family. Had sheep, cattle and crops.

Fanmore Croft – Mr and Mrs Duncan Mackinnon and family. Their son, Hugh, saw active service in 1914-18. Had sheep, cattle and grew crops.
